## Project Description

The Canoe Creek Hydropower Project is on a tributary to the Kennedy River on the west coast of Vancouver Island. This is a 5 MW run-of-the-river power generation facility that discharges to the anadromous fish barrier. The project is majority owned by the Tla-o-qui-aht First Nation.



## Our Role in the Project

- Supporting the Environmental Assessment required to obtain project permitting including:
  - Wildlife and vegetation
  - Water quality
  - Fish and invertebrate populations
  - Instream flow assessment
- Environmental monitoring for construction.
- Maintaining the hydrometric monitoring program and IFR compliance monitoring.
- Data collection and analysis to support the Long-Term Environmental Monitoring Program.
