This is a full-time opportunity for the position of Environmental Monitor, supporting our EDI team and our Indigenous partnerships on various projects throughout western Canada. In this position, you will be responsible for developing/implementing various Environmental Management Plans to confirm compliance with permit conditions and project commitments. This will be achieved through conducting on-site environmental inspections/audits, monitoring work activities in relation to environmental protection, documenting the effectiveness of environmental protection measures and providing corrective measure recommendations. You will be responsible for data collection, data management and preparing technical summary reports outlining your findings, as well as communicating with clients, regulators, and contractors. Depending on the position and your qualifications, you may also provide support for other environmental management programs on site including sediment and erosion control, water quality monitoring, fish or amphibian salvage, pre-clearing bird- or wildlife surveys, and reclamation activities.
